### **Preflight Single Check**

After you have created a custom check, it will appear in the Preflight panel (Edit > Preflight).

1. In the Preflight panel, click on the Single Check you created.

Click on the Analyze button. If your PDF contains one or more images with a resolution below 200 Pixels / Inch in this case, you will see a warning in the Preflight panel.
