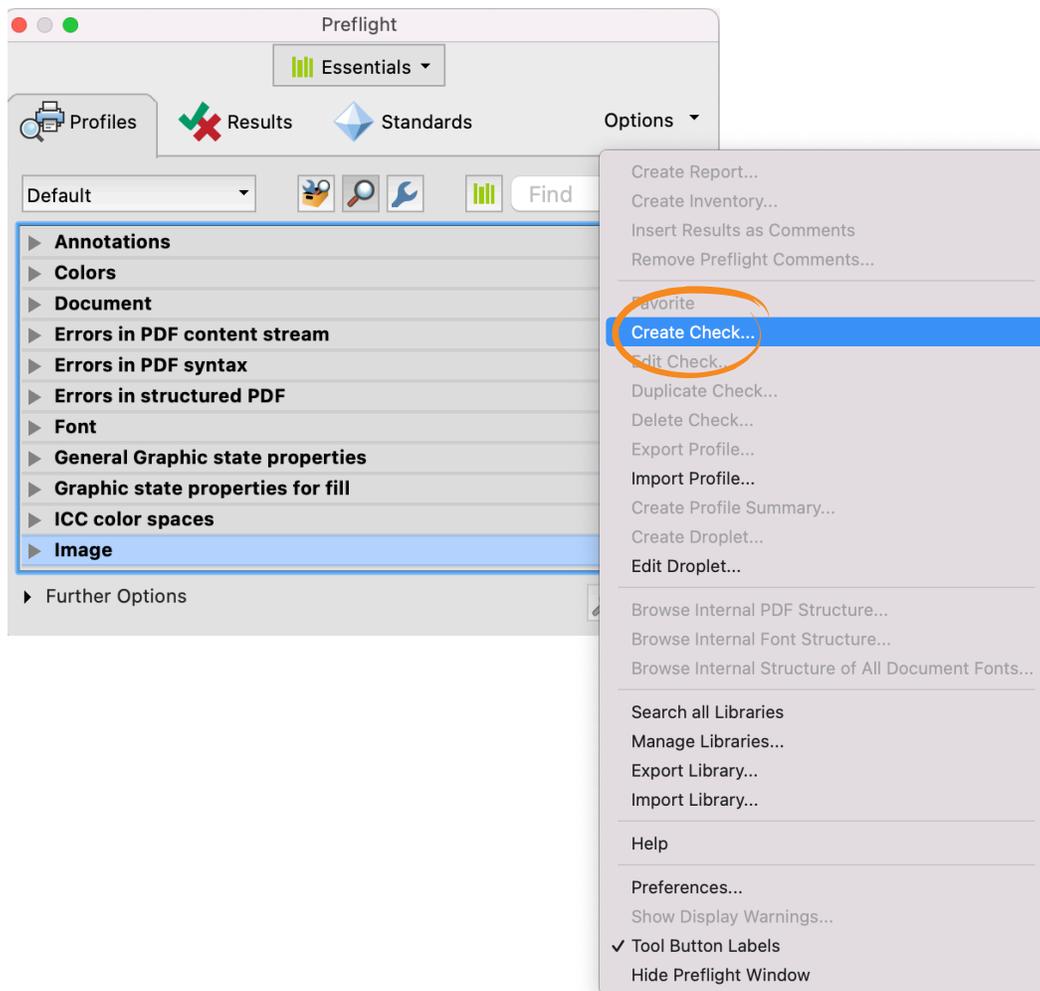


Acrobat–Image Resolution

Preflight

The following steps show you how to create a Preflight Check to check image resolution and flag images below 200 Pixels / Inch. Of course, you can always change the image resolution number.

1. Open Adobe Acrobat Pro.
2. Choose Preflight from the Edit menu (Edit > Preflight...).
3. Click on Options and choose Create Check...

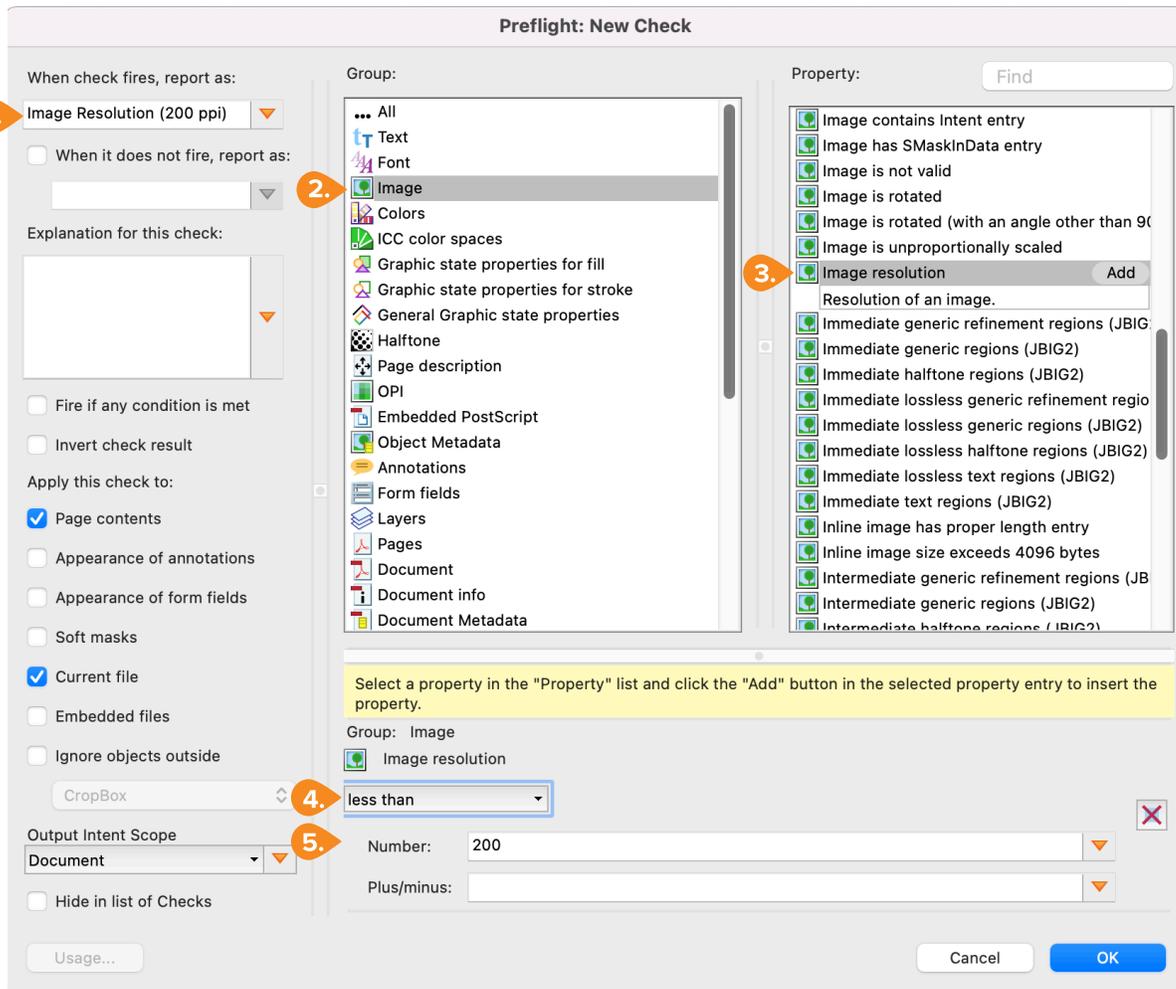

Creating a Check

1. Enter a name for your New Check.
2. Click on Image from the Group list.
3. Click on Image Resolution from the Property list.
4. Choose less than from the pop-up menu.
5. Enter a resolution amount. We recommend 200 Pixels / Inch.



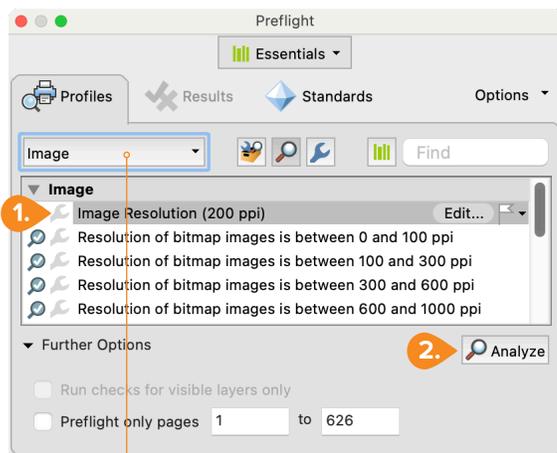

Preflight Single Check

After you have created a custom check, it will appear in the Preflight panel (Edit > Preflight).

1. In the Preflight panel, click on the Single Check you created.
2. Click on the Analyze button. If your PDF contains one or more images with a resolution below 200 Pixels / Inch in this case, you will see a warning in the Preflight panel.



TIP Choose Image from the pop-up menu.
