


InDesign–Exporting to PDF from the Book panel

If your project consists of multiple InDesign files, we recommend using a Book file, which is a collection of documents that can share styles, swatches, parent pages, and other items. You can sequentially number pages in booked documents, print selected documents in a book, or export them to PDF.

This guide covers the steps to Export Book to PDF from a Book panel with multiple InDesign documents added.

1. Open a Book file (File > Open...) or Create a new Book file (File > New > Book...)
2. Choose Export Book to PDF...



Add InDesign documents to the Book panel





Choose our Adobe PDF Preset (Walsworth_PDFPreset_7_21_20), then click on the Create Separate PDF Files check box.




Incremental Numbers
Page Number
Page Size

Typically use can use the Page Number, but if you did a new section start after the Table of Contents, for example, then use Incremental Numbers.



After you Export Separate PDFs to a folder, each PDF should have a page number at the end similar to the example below.

Having the page numbers at the beginning of the file name is preferred and although there are several ways to do that, we recommend using [A Better Finder Rename](#) (macOS) & [Better File Rename](#) (Windows).
