


InDesign-Adjusting your Document Size

Adjust Layout

When you need to adjust the size of your document, the **Adjust Layout** feature can do much of the work automatically by adjusting the page elements in your document layout when the page size, page margin, or bleed of the document changes.

- Choose Adjust Layout (File > Adjust Layout or File > Document Setup and click Adjust Layout.
- 2 Change the Page Size to match the Width and Height of the final trim size which may be different than this example.
- Margins must be a minimum of an 1/8" (.125 in) inside the trim, including Page Numbers.
- 4. Bleed, images and backgrounds intended to extend to the edge of the page, must be extended an 1/8" (.125 in) beyond trim.
